BY-LAW NUMBER 3/2019

**BEING A BY-LAW OF MOSSEY RIVER MUNICIPALITY TO
ESTABLISH THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON A HIGHWAY OR
PORTION OF A HIGHWAY UNDER THE RESPONSIBLE TRAFFIC
AUTHORITY'S JURISDICTION**

WHEREAS The Highway Traffic Act C.C.S.M., c. H60 gives a traffic authority the ability to establish a speed limit up to 90 km/h for any geographic area, highway, or portion of a highway for which it is the responsible traffic authority;

AND WHEREAS Section 6 of the Traffic Authority Speed Limits Regulation provides that a bylaw of a traffic authority must:


- a) Describe any portions of highway to which the speed limit applies, either by reference to a specific highway and the points on the highway at which the speed limit begins and ends or by reference to the boundaries of a geographic area.
- b) Indicate whether the speed limit applies at all times or applies seasonally.
- c) If the speed limit applies seasonally, indicate the day that the speed limit starts and that it ends in each year.
- d) Be accessible to the public.

AND WHEREAS Council for Mossey River Municipality deems it advisable and in the public interest to fix a speed limit for the highways or portions of highways, for which Mossey River Municipality has jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Mossey River Municipality enacts as follows;

1. That the maximum speed limits on highways under Mossey River Municipality's jurisdiction at all times of the year is prescribed in Schedule "A" that is attached and forms part of this bylaw.

Geographic Description	Speed Limit	Location
First Street – Fork River	50 km/h	In the vicinity of the community of Fork River lying between the point where the western boundary of P.T.H. No. 20 crosses the highway and the point where the northern boundary of the SE-26-29-19 WPM crosses the highway.
Community of Fork River	50 km/h	The highways and portions of highways in the community of Fork River that are within the following described boundaries: a) bounded on the north by the northern boundary of the SE-26-29-19 WPM; b) bounded on the south by the northern bank of the Fork River; c) bounded on the west by a line parallel to and perpendicularly distant westerly 600 m from the western boundary of P.T.H. No. 20; d) bounded on the east by the western boundary of P.T.H. No. 20.
Bridge Street	50 km/h	In the vicinity of the community of Winnipegosis lying between the point where the southern boundary of section 10-31-18 WPM crosses the highway and the point where the northern boundary of P.R. No. 364 crosses the highway.
Community of Winnipegosis	50 km/h	The following geographic area: The E ½ and SW ¼ of Section 10 and SE ¼ of Section 15 all in the Township 31-18 WPM.
Stanley Street	50 km/h	From Grenon Avenue to Victoria Avenue.
Road 182 N	50 km/h	From Stanley, 200 m to the West.
Road 181 N	50 km/h	From Bridge Street to Road 104 W.
Road 104 W	50 km/h	From Road 181N to P.R. No. 364.
Remaining Area of Mossey River Municipality	90 km/h	All areas of Mossey River Municipality not listed above.
