4.1 2020 Gravelling Program Update

Gravelling has been completed. Update to be given shortly regarding cost of hauling from Dyck's. Will be given to Council when received.

4.2 2020 Mowing/Brushing Program

Public Works staff have begun mowing program on third grade roads as per council's instruction.

4.3 Semi-Truck Update

Truck is still in Dauphin for the MPI claim process and is not expected back for at least three weeks.

4.4 Weiden Drain - Low Level Crossing

Water levels are dropping at the low level crossing on the Weiden Drain. Material was removed from crossing to allow water to spill over and improve overland flooding surrounding the crossing. Westlake Watershed will be surveying the crossing and surrounding land to the south to determine if additional work needs to be done to the crossing such as a reset of the culverts in the crossing. A licence would be required to reset the culverts.

5 Landfill - Sustainable Development Inspection Reports Review

The CAO and Public Works staff are working together to clean the Fork River and Winnipegosis Waste Disposal Sites. The household waste pits at both locations are full and require new pits to be dug. The CAO will investigate the process. The week of Monday July 20 to Friday, July 25th will be the major clean up week. The Green Team students, and three MMF summer students will be assisting with the cleanup. The CAO will keep council informed of the progress.
