We explained that the water & sewer did not play a part in this SSL and that we are currently looking at expanding the street lights in his area. We also confirmed that they did receive dust control and will continue to get it on their street moving forward.

Mr. Hucaluk did not want to forward his objection to the Municipal Board.

3.3 Presentation of Objection by William & Patricia Langlois

Mr. & Mrs. Langlois had concerns with SSL 5-2025 as they feel they haven't received some of the services associated with the SSL. We explained that we are currently working on expanding the street lighting services in their area as well as will be addressing some of the drainage concerns they were dealing with. They also had concerns of the lack of dust control which will be addressed moving forward.
